

ALBERTA WIN AND ALBERTARELM LICENCE REPRINT CHECKLIST

Alberta Starting Point

Alberta anglers need an active Wildlife Identification Number (WiN) before buying a recreational fishing licence.

Use My Wild Alberta and AlbertaRELM for online purchase and reprint paths.

Step 1: Confirm The WiN

- **Find the WiN tied to the licence purchase.**
- If you cannot find the WiN, use the account recovery or issuer support path.
- Avoid creating a second profile if you already have a WiN.
- Confirm the WiN is active before trying to buy or reprint.

Step 2: Reprint From AlbertaRELM

- **Open AlbertaRELM or the linked My Wild Alberta purchase path.**
- Sign in with the profile used for the original purchase.
- Look for current licences, purchase history, or reprint options.
- Reprint or download the licence if the purchase appears in the account.
- Save a copy before the trip.

Step 3: Paper Or App Proof

- **Alberta publishes AlbertaRELM as the official app path for carrying licences electronically.**
- A paper licence remains the simplest backup when travelling.
- Do not rely on a bank receipt or memory of purchase as your only proof.
- Keep the app available offline where possible and carry photo ID.

Step 4: If Online Recovery Fails

- **Use an Alberta licence issuer if the trip is urgent.**
- Use the support line or issuer when the account, WiN, name, or date of birth record is wrong.
- For licences bought through an issuer, ask whether the issuer can reprint the

licence.

- Expect a small issuer reprint fee if the reprint is handled outside your online account.

Step 5: Before Fishing

- Confirm the licence is active for the date.

- Confirm whether the trip needs a regular sportfishing licence, special harvest licence, national park permit, or another product.
- Confirm the waterbody, season, species limits, bait rules, and closures.
- Save proof before leaving cell service.
