Use: Send when the buyer's province is New Brunswick or the message mentions NB Outdoors Card, Fish and Wildlife Licensing System, Fish NB Days, or electronic licence proof.

New Brunswick Starting Point

New Brunswick uses an Outdoors Card number and the Fish and Wildlife Licensing System.

The Outdoors Card number is required to buy an angling licence, but the card itself is not the fishing licence.

Step 1: Recover The Outdoors Card Number

â€¢ Find the Outdoors Card number used for the licence purchase.

â€¢ If you registered at a vendor or Service New Brunswick, use the online user setup path if needed.

â€¢ Do not treat the mailed Outdoors Card as the licence.

â€¢ If the card number is missing, contact Fish and Wildlife Branch or use Service New Brunswick support.

Step 2: Reprint Or Show The Licence

â€¢ Sign in to the Fish and Wildlife Licensing System.

â€¢ Look for current licences or purchase history.

â€¢ New Brunswick FAQ says licences can be reprinted online at no charge if you have internet and a printer.

â€¢ New Brunswick also accepts electronic copies of licences under the current electronic licensing rules.

Step 3: Check Licence Class

- â€¢ Non-resident salmon and non-resident angling are different products.
- â€¢ Resident, senior, youth, salmon, live release, ice fishing, and Crown Reserve situations can change the licence class.
- â€¢ Do not assume Fish NB Days removes all restrictions.

Step 4: Fish NB Days

Fish NB Days can remove the angling licence requirement for residents and non-residents on listed dates, but other limits and closures still apply.

Before relying on Fish NB Days:

â€¢ confirm the exact date

â€¢ confirm the water is open

â€¢ confirm catch limits and closures

â€¢ confirm Crown Reserve, Crown lease, private water, or revoked-privilege restrictions

Step 5: What To Carry

â€¢ Electronic or printed licence proof.

â€¢ Outdoors Card number if needed for account access.

â€¢ Photo ID when useful.

â€¢ Salmon or special-water documents if the licence class requires them.
