Use: Send when the buyer's province is Nova Scotia or the message mentions a General Fishing Licence, sportfishing licence, salmon licence, or report card.

Nova Scotia Starting Point

Nova Scotia freshwater sportfishing uses a General Fishing Licence for most freshwater fishing except salmon. Salmon uses a separate licence.

Step 1: Confirm The Licence Type

â€¢ **General Fishing Licence: freshwater species except salmon.**

â€¢ Salmon Fishing Licence: Atlantic salmon in fresh water.

â€¢ Tidal or salt water: a provincial licence may not be required, but rules still apply.

â€¢ National parks and special waters can have separate requirements.

Step 2: Find The Licence Proof

â€¢ **Check the email used during online application.**

â€¢ Search for 'Nova Scotia sportfishing', 'General Fishing Licence', 'salmon licence', or the purchase date.

â€¢ Open the online application path if you need account or application support.

â€¢ Save the licence to your phone or print a paper copy.

Step 3: Replace A Lost Licence

Nova Scotia says lost licences can be replaced at a local Department of Natural

Resources and Renewables office.

Use a local office when:

â€¢ the online application is not enough to recover the licence

â€¢ the licence was issued through an in-person path

â€¢ the trip is close and you need a person to help

Step 4: What To Carry

â€¢ Printed licence or phone-accessible licence.

â€¢ Photo ID if useful to match your licence details.

â€¢ Salmon licence if the trip is for Atlantic salmon.

â€¢ General Fishing Licence Report Card or Salmon Fishing Licence Report Card obligations if they apply.

Step 5: Before Fishing

â€¢ Confirm the season and waterbody.

â€¢ Confirm species rules, gear rules, size limits, and bag limits.

â€¢ Confirm whether the water is freshwater, tidal, salt water, national park, or private/special water.

â€¢ Remember that General Fishing Licence holders need to submit the report card after the season.
