

ONTARIO LICENCE SUMMARY RECOVERY CHECKLIST

Use: Send when the buyer's province is Ontario or the message mentions an Outdoors Card, HuntFishOntario, or a missing Ontario licence summary.

Ontario Starting Point

Most Ontario anglers need an Outdoors Card and a fishing licence tag. A one-day fishing licence is the main exception because Ontario says it can be bought without an Outdoors Card.

Step 1: Decide Whether The Problem Is The Card Or The Licence

⚡ **Outdoors Card problem: the account, card number, renewal, replacement, or mailed card is the issue.**

⚡ Licence Summary problem: the fishing tag or proof document is missing.

⚡ Expired card problem: an expired Outdoors Card can affect the attached licence tag.

⚡ One-day licence problem: the purchase may not use the same card workflow.

Step 2: Sign In And Find The Licence Summary

⚡ Open HuntFishOntario.

⚡ Sign in with the account tied to the Outdoors Card.

⚡ Look for 'My Outdoors Card', 'My Licences', 'Licence Summary', or purchase history.

⚡ Download the Licence Summary as the official document to carry.

⚡ Save the PDF to your phone and email a backup to yourself.

Step 3: If The Outdoors Card Is Missing

⚡ **Replace or renew through the Ontario service, by phone, at a licence issuer, or at participating ServiceOntario locations.**

â€¢ Ontario says the physical card can take up to 20 business days by mail.

â€¢ While waiting, use the Licence Summary as the practical proof document for the fishing licence.

â€¢ If the card has not arrived after the published timeline, use Ontario's support contact path instead of starting a second account.

Step 4: What To Carry

â€¢ **Licence Summary PDF or printed copy.**

â€¢ Outdoors Card number or physical card if you have it.

â€¢ Photo ID when it helps match the account details.

â€¢ Any extra document required for the waterbody, species, or special permit.

Step 5: Before Fishing

â€¢ **Confirm the licence year and expiry date.**

â€¢ Confirm Sport vs Conservation if catch limits matter.

â€¢ Confirm the Fisheries Management Zone, season, species limit, and local exceptions.

â€¢ Do not rely on a payment receipt alone if the Licence Summary is missing.
